David A. Bomback, MD, Specializing in Spinal Surgery and Scoliosis Joins the Staff at Danbury Hospital

Earlier this year, Dr. Bomback completed a fellowship in spine and scoliosis surgery at the Hospital for Special Surgery in New York, NY. This was following his residency in orthopedic surgery and an internship in general surgery at Yale University School of Medicine, Yale-New Haven Hospital, from 1999-2004. At Columbia University, Dr. Bomback earned a medical degree from Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons along with a bachelor's degree in biological sciences, graduating Cum Laude from Columbia College, in 1999 and 1995, respectively. At Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons, he was the recipient of numerous honors and awards, including the Doctor Harry S. Altman Award for Outstanding achievement in pediatric ambulatory care, the Herbert J. Bartelstone Award for Exceptional accomplishments in pharmacology, the Robert G. Bertsch Prize for surgery and the Rosamond Kane Cummins '52 Award.

At Yale-New Haven Hospital, Dr. Bomback was awarded the Wayne O. Southwick Orthopaedic Surgery Award for spine surgery and the O. Donald Chrisman Award. In May of 2003, Dr. Bomback was recognized in the New York Metropolitan Area Resident Research Symposium for Orthopaedic Research and Education Foundation as the 3rd Place Award Recipient.

Dr. Bomback is board eligible in orthopedic surgery and licensed in New York and Connecticut. He is a member of the North American Spine Society, American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons, Alpha Omega Alpha Society and the Yale Orthopedic Association.
